

Hallmarks of Individualized Instruction

- ❑ Individualized instruction is a noncompetitive approach
- ❑ Students work at their own pace
- ❑ The teacher is the primary resource
- ❑ Students don't look to their peers for support
- ❑ Working alone can be isolating
- ❑ Working alone can be boring
- ❑ Individualized instruction requires students to have a degree of independence
- ❑ Record keeping for an individualized instruction approach is labor intensive
