

Helping Transient Students Succeed in School

Transient students benefit from placement options, which offer:

- transition classrooms (i.e., pre-K for young fives, pre-first for young sixes, pre-2nd for young sevens, etc.)
- multiage classrooms
- looping classrooms
- classrooms with a small class size
- small schools
- counseling services
- social worker services
- breakfast/lunch programs
- remediation (i.e., math, reading, etc.)
- tutoring in the core subject areas
- enrollment in before/after-school programs
- medical care services
- ESL/LEP support services when applicable
- placement with an experienced teacher

AND

- living quarters which qualify under Section 8 housing.

Note: Grade-level retention is considered an inappropriate intervention for most transient students. The exception may be when transience is *due to military orders*.
